Two weeks ago, on April 30, 2024, Petitioner Laura Owens ("Ms. Owens" or "Petitioner") filed an emergency motion seeking an order striking a pleading filed by Respondent entitled "Reply to Petitioner's Response to Respondent's *Amended* Motion for Relief Based on Fraud". That same Motion to Strike contained an emergency request for a scheduling conference, as is required by Rule 76.1.

The Court has not yet taken any action with regard to either request. Nevertheless, undersigned counsel submits this notice to inform the Court of two points relating to these pleadings.

First, undersigned counsel will <u>not</u> be available for an in-person hearing on the following dates: <u>May 14–18</u>, and <u>May 20<sup>th</sup></u>. Undersigned counsel is not available on May 14<sup>th</sup> due to a hearing in another matter, and is not available on the other dates due to a recently-arisen family matter that requires out of state travel. Counsel remains available for a *telephonic* hearing on May 16<sup>th</sup> or 17<sup>th</sup> but not May 15<sup>th</sup> or 20<sup>th</sup>.

Second, on April 26, 2024, Petitioner filed a pleading entitled "Petitioner's Response to Respondent's *Amended* Motion For Relief Based on Fraud." It has since been determined that pleading contains a minor factual error – on page 8 at lines 18–21, the pleading summarized the CV of Petitioner's expert, Dr. Michael Medchill (the CV was also included with the pleading). In the summary of Dr. Medchill's educational experience, the pleading stated Dr. Medchill "also separately holds a Ph.D. in immunology/biology".

As it turns out, all information in Dr. Medchill's CV was and is accurate, but the undersigned misunderstood the reference to a Ph.D degree. Based on further discussions with Dr. Medchill, it is accurate to say that in addition to his medical and other degrees, Dr. Medchill also *started* working on his Ph.D. in immunology/biology and was a Ph.D. *candidate* as his CV indicates, but he did not, in fact, complete his Ph.D. degree. This minor error (which was solely based on undersigned counsel misinterpreting the information in Dr. Medchill's CV) has no impact on either his qualifications to serve as an expert or the opinions stated in his report.
