- I, Gary Steiner, swear that I am currently registered as a Private Process Server pursuant to Rule 4(c) of the Arizona Rules of Civil Procedure. I further swear that on August 12, 2021 I received; <u>Summons</u>, <u>Civil Complaint</u>, <u>Certificate Of Compulsory Arbitration and Numerous Exhibits</u> from The Plaintiff.
- 2. I then proceeded to unsuccessfully serve the above described documents on Gregory

  Gillespie on three attempts at his home,
- 3. On August 12, 2021 at approximately 7:55 pm I approached the house and there was a white Lexus RX 350 in the middle of the driveway. I noticed all the shutters were drawn and shut and it was difficult to see if there were lights on. I rang the bell and heard the soft howl of a larger dog and he put his paws on the windowsill, under the wooden blinds. After ringing the bell 10 times over about 10 minutes, I finally left.
- 4. On August 15, 2021 at approximately 8:05 am I arrived to find a Dark Toyota 4Runner parked on the left side of the driveway. I rang the bell again and heard the dog the first few times and

then the dog was no longer near the door. In my experience if no one is home a dog will stay at the door, barking. If the owner is home, the dog will retreat to the owner and return unless held by the owner to keep it quiet. After the last 5-6 rings of the doorbell, the dog was no longer in the living room and no one came to the door.

- 5. On August 16, 2021 at approximately 8:55 pm I arrived and saw the bottom of the blinds were lifted about 6 inches and there was a light on in the kitchen. I rang the bell and heard the dog and saw it in the living room. It was sitting and facing the kitchen. I rang the bell another 6-7 times and kept looking for movement in the house, under the blinds, but no one appeared.
- 6. I was told the Defendant was aware he was going to be served and has purposely avoided opening the door to anyone he doesn't know. It is my professional opinion that Gregory is evading service and I highly recommend Alternative Service where we can post it to the door.
  I DO NOT believe he will answer the door to anyone he doesn't recognize.
- 7. This is considered to be personal service.
- 8. The fee I charged for this service was \$55.
